

Incident report- Jan-Mar 2019

05/01/19- Poachers in woodland between Plumpton and Calthwaite. Sounded like several people with dogs.

20/01/19- Works van broken into overnight in Armathwaite and a chainsaw and motorised wench was stolen. Believed to be linked to a series of similar incidents that happened that night in areas surrounding Carlisle.

01/02/19- 2 males seen walking through the village of High Hesket at 05:50am- thought to be suspicious however patrols had driven through round about the same time and had not seen anyone.

07/02/19- At some point in the week prior to 07/02, a building site in Plumpton had been broken into. Approximately 20 lintels were stolen with an approximate value of £400.

09/02/19- Suspicious low loader on the A6 near Plumpton loading something onto the back at 23:40pm.

12/02/19- Reports of an ongoing fox hunt through a private woods near Aiketgate.

15/02/19- Store cabin broken into overnight on building site in Plumpton and keys from a key locker taken. Other than that, nothing else had been stolen.

24/02/19- Male described as 20-30years old, wearing a black hoody, blue jeans and a black backpack walking along the railway line at Calthwaite. BTP (British Transport Police) dealt and searched the line in the area however could not locate the male.

04/03/19- Poachers near Cotehill. 3 lads were located and details were taken.

05/03/19- Reports of a suspicious vehicle that had been seen for the past few days parked up at Colt Close, near Southwaite was located and stop checked. Thought to be a parking up out of the way to smoke cannabis.

08/03/19- Blue Ford Transit Panel van entered a farm in Southwaite and the male driver stated he was selling rugs- this is suspicious behaviour.
