10/20/3 Planning Applications: RESOLVED that the Council were informed of a request by

Planning Applications: RESOLVED that the Council were informed of a request by Mr Fisher to reconsider his planning application, 20/0484 at land at Southwaite, CA4 OLL, for outline permission for the erection of two local occupancy dwellings with all matters reserved. The Parish Council had previously objected to the application on material grounds. Mr Fisher addressed these as follows:

- i. National Planning Policy concerns over noise impact have been addressed with a revised site plan and a new noise survey, which stipulates conditions to be attached to any planning approval to mitigate noise impact.
- ii. Highways visibility splay information has now been provided which is considered acceptable by Cumbria Highways.
- iii. Local Planning Policy the site is located at the edge of the settlement of Southwaite. The adjoining filed has a very sharp incline, and would not be viable for further housing. The applicant would therefore request that his application be classified as rounding off, in accordance with planning policies LS1 and HS2. As per the policy, both properties would be of a style which reflects neighbouring properties and would be for local occupancy only, for which there is high demand in Southwaite.

RESOLVED that Councillors voted to support the application on the grounds of local planning policy as it fulfils the criteria for rounding off and fulfils local demand for such properties in Southwaite.
