Minutes of the Ordinary Parish Council Meeting of Hesket Parish Council held on Tuesday 12th September 2023 at 7.30pm at Low Hesket Village Hall.

O9/23/1 Apologies for absence: RESOLVED that the following apologies were received;

- a) Councilor Martin, due to vacation;
- b) Councilor Campbell, due to prior commitment;
- c) Councilor Williamson, due to vacation.
- d) Councilor Dowes, apologies received.
- **O9/23/2 Declaration of interests: RESOLVED** that no declarations were made.
- **Minutes: RESOLVED** that the minutes of the Ordinary Parish Council Meeting held on Tuesday 10th July 2023 were confirmed as a true record and were signed by the Chair.
- **O9/23/4 Matters arising from the minutes: RESOLVED** that the following matters were raised:
 - a) Overgrowing trees that have not been cut back, at Southwaite, Calthwaite and High Hesket. Clerk to follow up with Highways.
- **O9/23/5** Chair's announcements: RESOLVED that none were made
- **O9/23/6 Public Participation: RESOLVED** that there were no public present.
- **O9/23/7**Westmorland and Furness Council Report: RESOLVED that Councilor Carrick informed the Council that following a retendering process for home to school transport several issues have arisen, which she is working to resolve. Councilor Carrick further informed the meeting that inspections had been carried out of school buildings in the former Eden District under the previous County Council, and no RAAC concrete was present in these buildings. Other Council owned buildings were now under a rolling inspection, and problems may arise. Councilor Carrick announced that Westmorland and Furness Council had approved a scheme of introducing limited number of 20mph zones, with a budget allocated to each locality area.
- **O9/23/8** Cumbria Police Report: RESOLVED that the Clerk read a report from PCSO Erica Normans to the meeting with the following instances noted;
 - a) 13/07- 01:15hrs, 3 young men seen looking around machinery in a shed at Mellguards, when challenged they ran off and got in a vehicle that was waiting by the gates; the car switched its lights off and drove away at speed. Believe it may have been a Ford Fiesta. Another vehicle was also waiting by the gate that had a further 2 males and a female in, this was a white VW Polo. Nothing was stolen but logged as a suspicious incident.
 - b) 20/08- Driver arrested on a back road near Calthwaite for drug driving
 - c) 23/08- Vehicle uplifted by police for having no tax at Thiefside
 - d) Between 01/09 and 02/09, overnight break in at Genesis site in Calthwaite, a generator and paint sprayer were stolen
 - e) 02/09- Report of a drink driver at High Hesket on the A6 travelling towards Carlisle, Penrith officers caught up to the vehicle and the driver was arrested for driving over the prescribed limit of alcohol.
 - f) There are also daily calls for service up at Southwaite services for males selling broken TVs from white vans. We are currently dealing with this as a priority due to the number of reports of the same offenders

09/23/9 **Grants: RESOLVED** that following grants were approved:

09/23/10 Armathwaite Old School Hall: RESOLVED that the hall has given a portion of field to allow access from the car park to the garden. Following advice from Westmorland and Furness Council, they have requested that the Parish Council makes the application on their behalf, ad this will reduce costs. It was confirmed that submitting an application would not leave the Council with any liability or costs, therefore Councilors agreed to submit the application on their behalf. (Proposed by Councilor Waugh, seconded by Councilor Everingham).

09/23/11 Grass verge, Armathwaite: RESOLVED that Councilors agreed to adopt the grass verge outside the Old School Hall, Armathwaite, on behalf of the Helping Armathwaite Wildlife Group, on condition that the group sign an agreement with the Parish Council to maintain the verge to a reasonable standard. (Proposed Councilor Everingham, seconded by Councilor Pollock).

Milestones: RESOLVED that Councilors agreed to apply for listing of milestones within the Parish. 09/23/12 It was also acknowledged that the milestone outside Boggle Hall, Plumpton had been restored, and costs as agreed would be paid to Terry Moore of the Milestone Society. Mr. Moore was thanked for his work.

Planning applications: RESOLVED that the following comments were agreed on current planning applications in the Parish:
