Land gifted to Hesket Parish Council

- Armathwaite Play Area, Off Brackenrigg, Armathwaite, Carlisle. (1.3 acres)
 - Gifted by Border Engineering Contractor Ltd in 1981 for use as a playground.

Land owned by Hesket Parish Council, per Commons Registration Act 1965 ruling

- Land at Petteril Bridge, Plumpton, Penrith, unit number CL 129.
 - Currently maintained by parishioner on behalf of Parish Council.
- Land at Aiketgate, Carlisle, unit number VG46
 - Current rented to resident of Parish.

Land designated as Common Land per Commons Registration Act 1965 ruling cared for by Hesket Parish Council under section 9 of the Act

- Land at Crooks Bridge, Wreay, Carlisle, unit number CL 131.
 - Currently under Parish Council stewardship.

Land designated as Public Highway for which Hesket Parish Council takes responsibility for maintenance of, under the Highways Act 1980

- Land outside Glen Artney, Front Street, Armathwaite.
- Land on embankment on Front Street, Armathwaite.
- Land at village entrance at south end of High Hesket.
- Land at village entrance at north end of High Hesket.
- Land on the A6, at the bus shelter, Plumpton.
- Land on the A6, around the bench, opposite the turning for Southwaite.

Land designated as Common Land per Commons Registration Act 1965 where section 9 protection is provided by third party

- Land known as Great Barrock Wood Quarry, Hesket, Carlisle, unit number CL 128.
 - Currently maintained by GNAR Bike Park Ltd.

Other land designated as Common Land per Commons Registration Act 1965 with section 9 protection

- Land known as The Old Well, Armathwaite, Carlisle, unit number CL 130.
 - Current status unknown, appears to be incorporated into boundaries of property known as Road Ends, Armathwaite, Carlisle.

Land designated as Common Land per Commons Registration Act 1965, later ruled void

- Land known as the Pinfold, High Hesket, Carlisle, unit number CL 432.

Land ruled to be under private ownership per Commons Registration Act 1965

- Land known as Armathwaite Quarry, near Armathwaite, Carlisle, unit number VG 45.
 - Owned by Mr E P Ecroyd. Low House, Armathwaite.
